

Nomination Criteria and General Voting Rules

General Rules:

The Jacksonville Gator City Senate will be holding elections for President, Sergeant at Arms and Treasurer on July 14, 2018, 3:00pm at Cassat Batt Bowl, 1838 Cassat Ave. Jacksonville, FL. 32210. Please send application and resume` of qualifications to the election committee (post marked) no later than July 5, 2017 for processing, if running from the floor, please turn in your application 30 minutes prior to the election meeting starting so it can be reviewed by the election committee.

Applications can be mailed to: TNBA Election Committee P.O. Box 9781, Jacksonville, Florida 32208, or hand delivered to the election committee prior to the beginning of the election meeting. Applications must be complete with all required supporting documentation.

Should the position being nominated from the floor be for Treasurer the proposed candidate must comply with Clause "A" of the nomination criteria.

Ballots shall be cast at the annual meeting on July 14, 2018

All members voting shall be reviewed for eligibility. Disallowed votes shall be discarded without being counted. Duplicate ballots cast by the same individual (excluding run-off balloting) will disqualify the vote and voter. Voting more than once per balloting may expose the offender to disciplinary action by the Senate.

(MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE GATOR CITY SENATE TO VOTE)

A simple majority wins, in the instance of a tie, a run-off vote shall be conducted during the annual meeting that evening.

Winners shall be announced the night of the election and posted thereafter.

Roberts's rules of order shall be observed beyond these guidelines.

General Qualifications for Office:

Required:

- Must be a TNBA member in good standing at time of application and election.
- Have participated in a minimum of two (2) Gator City Senate meetings in the past 12 months.
- Resume` of qualifications
- Platform

General Credentials:

- Ability to work with and manage people effectively.
- Integrity

- Ability to get things done
- Articulate, good writing skills
- Good judgment, evenness and balance.
- Ability to manage a meeting following proper rules and guidelines.

Desired Experience (not required):

Officer Candidates:

- Management experience in following fashion:
 - Lead an organization or manage with a span of control of at least 15 people.
 - Lead a team, committee or group of people through to conclusion of a project.
 - Served on a board of directors for a profit or non-profit organization. Chair a committee, the board, or serve as an officer of the board a plus.
 - Head and shoulder photo requested.

Treasurer:

- Management experience as described above plus:
 - Fiscal oversight of an organization or board.
 - Experience in accounting, CPA, financial officer or served on the finance (or budget) committee of a non-profit organization or for profit business.
 - Experience with income statements and balance sheets.
 - ***Clause “A” *** Required***: No felony conviction in connection with crimes involving money, money laundering, fraud, embezzlement, or found at fault with the misappropriation of Senate or League funds by its governing body (required). Sworn statement clause on application must be signed.***
