

General Voting Rules and Nomination Criteria

General Voting Rules:

The Jacksonville Gator City Senate will be holding elections for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Sergeant-at-Arms biennially.

All members voting must be a member of the Gator City Senate to vote.

All members voting should bring their current TNBA card. You must have your driver's license or state ID in order to receive a ballot.

Disallowed votes shall be discarded without being counted.

Duplicate ballots cast by the same individual (excluding run-off balloting) will disqualify the vote and voter.

Voting more than once per balloting may expose the offender to disciplinary action by the Senate.

A simple majority wins. In the instance of a tie, a run-off vote shall be conducted at a later date to be announced. Winners shall be announced on the day of the election and posted after that.

Roberts's rules of order shall be observed beyond these guidelines.

Nomination Criteria:

Applications must be complete with all required supporting documentation.

Required:

- Must be a TNBA Gator City Senate member in good standing during application and election.
- Have participated in a minimum of two (2) Gator City Senate meetings in the past 12 months.
- Resume of qualifications
- Platform

General Credentials:

- Ability to work with and manage people effectively.
- Integrity
- Ability to get things done
- Articulate, good writing skills
- Good judgment, evenness, and balance.
- Ability to manage a meeting following proper rules and guidelines.

Desired Experience:

Officer Candidates:

- Management experience in the following fashion:
 - Lead an organization or manage with a span of control of at least 15 people.
 - Lead a team, committee, or group of people through to the conclusion of a project.
 - Served on a board of directors for a profit or non-profit organization. Chair a committee, the board, or serve as an officer of the board a plus.
 - Head and shoulder photo requested.

Treasurer:

- Management experience as described above plus:
 - Fiscal oversight of an organization or board.
 - Experience in accounting, CPA, financial officer, or served on the finance (or budget) committee of a non-profit organization or for-profit business.
 - Experience with income statements and balance sheets.
 - **Clause “A” *** Requirement***:** No felony conviction in connection with crimes involving money, money laundering, fraud, embezzlement, or found at fault with the misappropriation of Senate or League funds by its governing body (required). **Sworn statement clause on the application must be signed.**
